1 Student Bridge Program



NTM donated \$500 to the Penn State Chapter of Bridges to Prosperity. In summer 2017, the Penn State Chapter constructed a footbridge in Kumusenyi, Rwanda for a community of 8,500 people.

2 Operation Backpack



NTM collected a total of 12 backpacks and numerous school supplies for the Volunteers of America PA's Operation Backpack collection, which provides school supplies to children across PA.
